Literacy

- Read the story of Tiddler, by Julia Donaldson.
- Innovate the poem, 'We're Going On A Bear Hunt'.
- Write in a range of genres, including a character study, a persuasive letter, poetry and information writing.
- Research and read eye witness accounts from survivors of the Titanic.

Numeracy

- Counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.
- Multiplication and division.
- Two step problems.
- Inverses and missing numbers
- Adding three numbers

How can you help?

-Read with your child at least three times a week.

-Provide your child with opportunities to develop fine motor skills through Hama beads, construction and by using a wide range of writing materials, e.g.

pens/pencils/felt tips/paints.

-Encourage them to write neatly, using joined up cursive letters when doing homework, writing birthday cards etc.

-Practise counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.

-Practise spelling high frequency words.

Other learning opportunities:

Art and DT- Sketch, collect digital images and make clay models of shells.

Geography- locate and name the UK capital cities, and surrounding seas. Use a compass to locate direction, identify the features of maps, and make our own maps, including a key. Locate and name the equator and the northern and southern hemispheres on a map of the world and a globe.

PSHE - Going for Goals.

PE - Explore a range of movements and skills.

RE - Easter through the theme of sadness to happiness.

History- learn about key historical figures such as Captain Cook, Sir Francis Drake and the pirates, Blackbeard and Ann Bonney. Examine events leading up to the sinking of the Titanic.

Science- compare local habitats in our school grounds with habitats found on the seashore and in the sea.

Research how an animal survives in its habitat.
